

VISA REQUIREMENTS IN SPAIN



- If you are a citizen of the European Union, Switzerland, Liechtenstein, Norway, or Iceland:
All you need is your Identification Card, or a valid passport.
- If you are from any of the following countries: Andorra, Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Brazil, Brunei, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, Croatia, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Japan, Malaysia, Mauritius, Mexico, Monaco, Nicaragua, New Zealand, Panama, Paraguay, Republic of Korea, San Cristobal and Nieves, San Marino, Seychelles, Singapore, (the) United States of America, Uruguay, (the) Vatican city, Venezuela.
All you need is a valid passport to enter Spain, where you can stay for a maximum of 90 days.
- If you are from any other country, according to EU criteria:
You must request a visa at the Spanish Consulate/Embassy in your country of residence. You will also need a valid passport.

Requirements are subject to change, so we recommend you to ask the nearest Spanish Embassy or Consulate about this information. You can check which the nearest Spanish Embassy or Consulate is on the website of the [Spanish Foreign Office](#)
